

DRAFT COMPENDIUM OF PROPOSED NATIONAL AND REGIONAL TRAINING INSTITUTIONS IN THE COMESA REGION TO BE ENGAGED ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AWARENSS AND SESITIZATION ON THE COMESA PROTOCOLS AND COMESA COUNCIL OF MINISTERS DECISIONS ON THE COMESA PROGRAMME ON FREE MOVEMENT OF PERSONS, LABOUR AND SERVICES.

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## **Background**

This Compendium of proposed national and regional training institutions in the COMESA region to be engaged on the implementation of the awareness and sensitization on the COMESA Protocols and COMESA Council of Ministers' decisions on the COMESA programme on free movement of persons, labour and services has been compiled as part of a project proposal on the awareness creation of COMESA Protocols and Council Decisions of the COMESA Programme on Free Movement of Persons. The objective of the project is to develop a programme of continued capacity building for stakeholders on the COMESA Programme on the COMESA Free Movement of Persons. The engagement with existing national and regional training regional institution into a formal partnership by COMESA is to ensure the sustainability of the capacity building programme, beyond the project that developed the training modules. The programme shall involve the conclusion of a Memorandum of Understanding between COMESA and the National or Regional Training through which COMESA shall hand over the training materials to training institution to include in their programme. Among other things, COMESA shall work with the training institution to mobilize financial and technical resources for the implementation of the programme.

## **Methodology of Compiling the Compendium**

The compendium has been compiled mainly through desk Research and consultation with Stakeholders from Member States. At this stage it is merely indicative as formal engagement with any national training institution shall require the engagement and approval of every Member State through a COMESA Coordinating Ministry in each country. This therefore means the compendium is subject to review at various stages and other training institutions may be recommended by Member States such as training institutions where immigration officers are trained.

The criteria used to identify the national training institutions is their capacity to offer training to both the public sector, the private sector and other non-state actors. The other criterion for their

identification is their capacity to offer training on issues that include regional integration, migration and related subjects.
