Southern Africa Migration Management (SAMM) Project Scholarships offered to obtain the "Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners"

2021 - 2024

The Southern Africa Migration Management Project (SAMM) offered scholarships to Southern African tripartite stakeholders with the objective of achieving the International Training Center of the International Labour Organisation's (ITC ILO) **Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners.** The Diploma offered an opportunity to participants to master the qualitative understanding of labour migration governance and protection of migrant workers' rights through a package of intensive and challenging training courses - distance learning and residential phases to be furthered complemented by a capstone project in one of the fields of expertise covered in the programme.

The scholarships were offered to 3 representatives of the Ministry of Labour + 3 representatives of workers' organisations + 3 representatives of employers' organisations of each of the 16 SADC countries. In addition, the SAMM project offered 9 scholarships per Regional Economic Community (SADC, COMESA, IOC): 3 to Ministries of Labour represented at the RECs level, and 3 to Workers' representation and Employers' representation each. In total, SAMM was able to offer 9 scholarships to each SADC country + 9 to each Regional Economic Community (RECs).

On achieving the Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners, successful candidates gained advanced knowledge in core areas of Labour Migration governance and cutting-edge skills to demonstrate the achievement through a recognised certification from the ITC ILO; and be part of a growing network of Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners to serve as an ongoing platform for exchange.

The training activities developed under the Diploma emphasized experiential, results-based, learner centred methodologies such as lectures, discussions, case studies, open discussion, role-play exercises and extensive group work in which learning needs were assessed and matched and aligned with principles and guidance intended to turn learning outcomes into practice under seven main thematic areas:

- 1. Gender-sensitive labour migration policies and/or strategies regulating labour migration at national and/or regional level;
- 2. International labour standards, national legislation on the protection of migrant workers and promoting the recognition of the positive contribution of migrant workers to sustainable development;

- 3. Bilateral labour migration agreements (BLMAs) across the region and with third countries;
- 4. Fair recruitment and decent employment for migrant workers including the monitoring of Private Employment Agencies (PEAs), strengthening of Public Employment Services (PES) as well as labour inspection capacity to improve working conditions;
- 5. Access to and Portability of Social Security Benefits for migrant workers;
- 6. Recognition of qualifications of migrant workers at national and bilateral level, as well as support to Regional Qualifications Frameworks at REC's level;
- 7. Labour migration statistics (indicators, module, inclusion in labour market information systems and labour force surveys, etc) guiding an evidence-based public discourse.




- 8. Labour Migration Administration;

- 11. Reducing Remittances' transfer cost;
- 12. The role of migrant workers and the Diaspora in attaining the SDGs.


Breakdown of SAMM Project scholarships to obtain the "Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners" 2021 – 2024


178 participants were selected as recipients of the SAMM Project scholarships to obtain the "Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners". The list of scholarship recipients was based on nominations from SADC tripartite constituents and RECs. Of the 178 who were invited to take part in the process, 117 participants were considered as active participants (Completing 1 or more courses). Of the 117 actively participating, 55 were male and 62 female. The majority 97 (83%) were English speakers followed by 16 (13.6%) French speakers and only 4 (3.4%) Portuguese speakers. The majority (37.3%) of scholarship beneficiaries belonged to representatives from Ministries of Labour followed by 26.9% from Workers organizations, 18.2% representatives from Government Agencies other than the Ministry of Labour and 10.4% from Employers Organizations. The remaining 7.2% is composed of representatives from Enterprise, Academia, NGOs, Training institutions, Public institutions and Intergovernmental organizations.


From the beginning of the SAMM project scholarships programme to obtain the "Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners", the participants were enrolled 401 times into the "Diploma eligible" courses of the ITCILO Labour Migration Cluster. Of the 401 enrolments, 251 culminated in Certificates of Achievement and 69 in certificates of participation. 83% of the participants enrolled succeeded in obtaining a certificate. As expected, the majority (63%) of participants obtained certificates of achievement.















Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners

While many scholarship recipients successfully completed one or two courses, **62 of them** obtained certificates of achievements for four or more courses (including the ITCILO Academy on Labour Migration). As a result, **62** participants were eligible to receive the ITCILO Diploma on Labour Migration for Experts and Practitioners and were enrolled in the Capstone phase as the final stage to obtain the Diploma.

- **50** out of the 62 participants (81%) completed all the tasks and reached the final step of the Diploma by submitting their Capstone Projects (fully engaged).
- 1 out of the 62 participants (2%) completed some of the Capstone Project tasks (fairly engaged)
- **11** out the 62 participants (18%) did not complete any of the Capstone Project activities (not engaged)



The 50 successful candidates were rewarded with the **Diploma for Labour Migration Experts and Practitioners** during two graduation ceremonies. The first ITC-ILO Graduation Ceremony was held in South-Africa in June 2024. In December of the same year, the second ITC-ILO Graduation Ceremony took place.

It is worth highlighting that outstanding capstone projects were presented by selected candidates during the graduation ceremonies.
